We are looking forward to seeing all of the new third graders in the fall. In order to remain terrific readers, we would like you to keep reading this summer. We will have one book that is required.

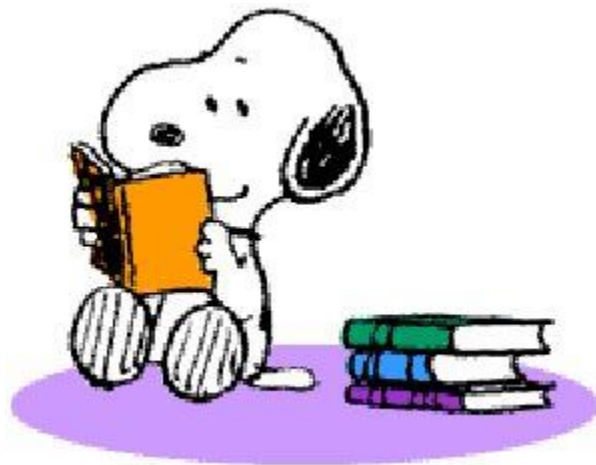
Required Reading: Third Grade Angels by Jerry Spinelli

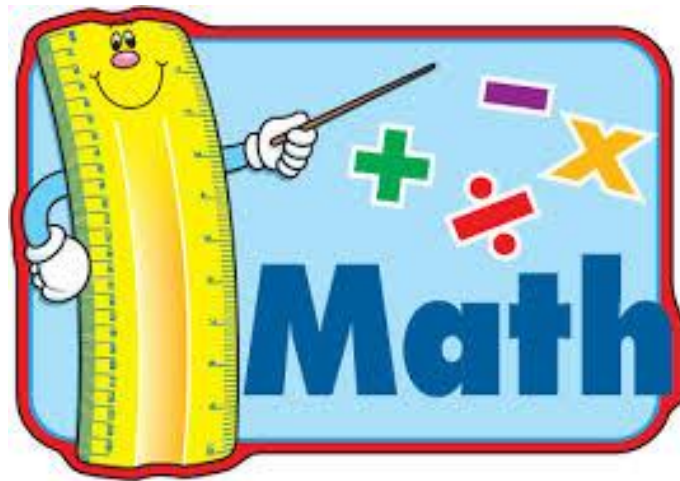
