

Fourth Grade Summer Requirements

Summer reading affords all students the opportunity to enjoy books in a relaxed and leisurely setting while developing a lifelong love of reading. I encourage my students and their families to engage in reading together this summer by exploring books of all kinds for information and enjoyment.

Research has shown that students who read during the summer months retain more learning and move into the new school year more prepared than do those students who do not engage in reading. It is important that all students continue to pursue this important academic skill.

This year's summer reading has one required book, and then at least one other of the student's choice. Please have your child complete the following reading assignments.

Required Reading:

***Frindle** by Andrew Clements - (All students must read this book.) - After reading the book, complete the book review form. There will be a quiz once we return to school in September.

* Students must then read at least **one** other book of their choice and complete a book review form.

Required Math - IXL: Over vacation students are also required to work through the list of 15 specified IXL Math skills. Students are to spend either 20 minutes on each skill or until they reach a Smart Score of 100 to show mastery of the skill.
