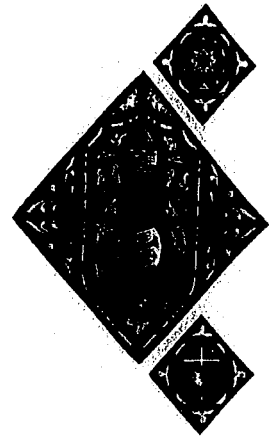

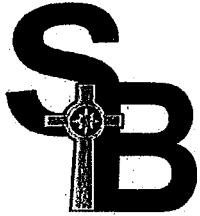

**Additional Information:**

- Each (K-8) family is required to sell 15 Dare-to-Dream fundraising tickets. Participation in this fundraiser is mandatory. All proceeds from this event go toward the cost of educating your child.
- Tuition is discounted the amount of our monthly processing fee (\$40) if you pay in full by August 7, 2018.
- All registered families not paying the full tuition by August 7<sup>th</sup> must enroll in our E-Tuition payment system. E-Tuition is an electronic payment system automatically transferring monthly tuition payments from your checking or savings account to St. Benedict's. The first E-Tuition payment is made Tuesday, August 15, 2018.

**Financial Assistance:** St. Benedict's School provides tuition assistance to families based on financial need. We continue to operate under the belief that no child should be denied a Catholic education for financial reasons. If your family has financial assistance needs, please contact Principal Mrs. Laurie Wojtaszczyk, (835-2518) to obtain financial aid applications. Application to Bison Fund Program is necessary before applying for financial aid direct from St. Benedict School.

Dear St. Benedict Parents & Prospective Parents:

Over the last several months the School Finance Committee, The Board of Education, and the Parish Trustees have been crafting the budget for the 2018-2019 school year. Each year, they work to ensure that during Catholic Schools Week everyone will know the tuition for the coming year as a part of the registration process.

All of the members of these groups are volunteers and in many cases parents of our school. They are sensitive to keeping tuition affordable but at the same time mindful of the need to make our school affordable to the parish. St. Benedict Parish will continue to contribute \$100,000 next year to subsidize the school budget. Like many Catholic parishes that are aging, the contributions continue to diminish making each year more difficult to subsidize the school. It would be so helpful for our school families to participate in the life of the parish by attending Mass regularly and contributing to the parish.

During the budget deliberations there were extensive discussions on how to continue to improve the school facility as well as the technology program for our students. This year we were able to replace the non-functioning PA system, install phones in every classroom, paint the school stage walls, install a few more whiteboards in the classrooms, and provide 1:1 student laptops for all 6th through 8th graders to use during the school day. Next year's budget continues to include funding for additional inventory so that over the next few years you will see laptops and iPads available for every student K-8.

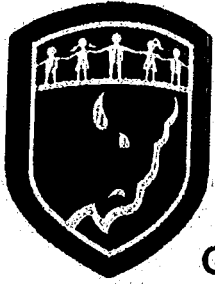
Due to the increase in school enrollment and controlled spending, it was possible to offer a 3% tuition increase next year. The technology fee will remain the same. This fee will be used to purchase hardware and to help defray the cost of services and infrastructure necessary to run the computer system. The technology fee is for students in K-8 and will be \$100 for the first student in a family and \$75 for each subsequent student family member.

Attached to this letter is the tuition and fee schedule for 2018-2019.

### step two

Watch for notification after the BISON Lottery is held in March. Winners are notified by email and wait-listed families are also notified.

### step four

Once all the steps are completed, BISON will notify you of your scholarship amount. Watch for notices to annually renew your BISON Scholarship in February.

## FAQ FOR FAMILIES

### Who qualifies for a BISON Scholarship?

Residents of the 8 counties of WY with children entering K-8 grade with a total family income within the eligibility range (see below). You may only apply for your biological or legal (planned) children.

### How do new families apply?

New families must complete a Pre-Application Form electronically (online) on our website at [www.bisonfund.com](http://www.bisonfund.com). The new family deadline is February 22, 2016. Preference is NOT given to early applications; however you must apply by 2/22 to be considered for the lottery. Families applying after the February 22nd deadline will be placed on our waitlist.

### How are BISON scholarship recipients chosen?

Scholarships are awarded using a lottery from an open raffle Pre-Application Form in March 2016. Lottery winners will receive a notification letter and must complete the application in order to receive the scholarship.

### How do I know if I won the lottery?

All applicants will be notified of lottery results by email in March 2016.

### I received a scholarship award email ... now what?

In your award email, there will be a link that will take you where you need to go to complete your Pre-Application. Click on the link and follow the application steps. The deadline to complete the application is April 30, 2016. Please be sure to include all income sources including your FEDERAL 1040 tax return, child support, business income, public assistance, food stamps, Social Security income, unemployment insurance, worker's compensation, and financial assistance from family & friends. Select your school to complete list can be found on our website and contact the school to complete the School Commitment Form. After receipt of all the required documents, your scholarship will be calculated based on your household size and income, as well as tuition amount. You must re-apply annually to continue with BISON.

### I received an email that I'm on a waitlist ... now what?

Unfortunately, there are always more applicants than available funding. We keep waitlist names for the academic year hopeful that additional funding becomes available. If you are not taken off the waitlist, you will need to resubmit a Pre-Application next year to be considered.

### Why do families have to pay part of the tuition?

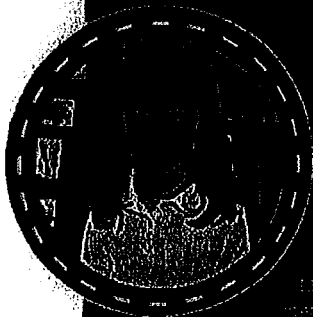
One key component of educational success is parental investment. Making a financial sacrifice is a strong incentive to becoming and remaining involved. BISON scholarships are a hand up, not a hand out. BISON families are required to pay a minimum of \$500 each year.

### What if I am not satisfied with my child's school?

You are free to transfer your student to another private school. Your scholarship will transfer with you unless you are delinquent with tuition payments or a child is asked to leave. Contact the BISON Fund office if you decide to transfer and we will walk you through the next steps.

### Can the scholarship be used for Pre-K or High School?

No. Children must be at least 5 years old by 12/21/13 and entering kindergarten through 8th grade to be eligible for a BISON scholarship.

Dear Parent(s),

We are continuing the electronic tuition collection program for the 2018-19 school year. Everyone is required to fill out a new Tuition Authorization Form. Enclosed with this letter is the Tuition Authorization form.

## Highlights of the 2018-19 tuition program

*(See the back for more details.)*

- All families must fill out and sign the Tuition Authorization Form.
- There are two choices for tuition payment. *(There are no exceptions.)*
  - Payment in full by August 7<sup>th</sup>. (Payment in full will receive a \$40.00 discount)
  - Payments monthly by electronic transfer from a checking/savings account.
- The Electronic Transfer option will be begin on August 15<sup>th</sup>. See the back for more information.
- Student(s) will not be allowed in the school without a completed form.

Here is the timeline for the 2018-19 tuition program:

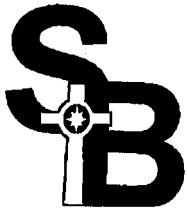
Feb 28	Bison Fund financial aid application due for families new to Bison.
April 1	Bison Fund requalification deadline for current Bison families.
April 1	Deadline for all returning families to register at \$125. The registration fee after April 1 <sup>st</sup> for any returning family will be \$175. (Required registration forms include Application, Tuition Authorization, Emergency Contact, and Registration Fee.)
June 30	Financial aid forms for St. Benedict Scholarship are due. (Bison Fund application is a prerequisite.)
July 31	Tuition bills are sent to all families with the amount owed for families who pay in full or with an electronic payment schedule for families choosing to pay monthly.
August 7	Payment in full is due. (\$40 discount to families who pay in full by August 7 <sup>th</sup> .)
August 15	First scheduled electronic payment. Payments will be deducted on the 15 <sup>th</sup> of every month for 10 months.
May 15	Families who do not sell the required number of Dare to Dream tickets will be billed for the unsold amount.

Our E-Tuition program was very successful last year. Our delinquency was very low. It is important that we collect tuition in a timely manner in order to maintain the financial stability of our school. Any question regarding the program should be directed to Scott Clare at the rectory (834-1041).

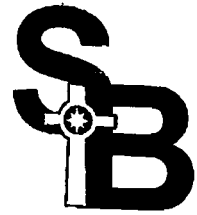
## ELECTRONIC TRANSFER PROGRAM

1. Tuition payments will be divided over 10 months – August through May.
2. All payments will be withdrawn from a checking/savings account on the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month. When the 15<sup>th</sup> falls on a weekend, the transfer will occur on the following Monday.
3. In the event of insufficient funds a second transfer will be attempted on the 30<sup>th</sup> of the month.
4. In the event of a rejected transfer because of insufficient funds, all fees will be the responsibility of the school family. Fees will be added to the next scheduled transfer.
5. In the event of exceptional circumstances, requests for blocking of payment must be submitted by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month.
6. Students entering during the school year will have their tuition payments prorated for the remaining months of the school year.
7. Students leaving the school will be responsible for the tuition for the remainder of the month in which they are leaving.

## **Additional Tuition Information**

1. If a family chooses EFT for payment, all bank fees associated with rejected transfers for insufficient funds will be the responsibility of the school family.
2. In the event of an electronic funds transfer rejection on the 15th of the month, there will be a second attempt to transfer the funds on the 30<sup>th</sup> of the month. If that transfer is rejected, there will be a late fee of \$20.00 assessed for that amount to the account.
3. All families are responsible for the sale of 15 Dare to Dream fundraiser tickets. Any unsold tickets will be added to the tuition payment beginning in the month of May.
4. Continuous delinquency on tuition payment may result in removal of the student(s) from the school.
5. Families who enter the school during the school year will have their tuition payments prorated based on the remaining months in the school year.
6. Families who leave the school during the school year will receive a prorated refund for any tuition paid in advance.
7. Registration and Technology fees are non-refundable.

## **Acknowledgement**
